

WAR IN THE SENATE! SOUTHERN SENATORS FLEE

Rumours abound throughout the capitol that while meeting in closed session yesterday attempts were made to arrest several high standing Southern Senators including the always popular Senators; Huckabee of Georgia, Kimes of Arkansas and Thompson of Mississippi.
